Wolfgang Bäumlér graduated as physicist 1987 and is currently working as medical physicist at the department of Dermatology, University of Regensburg, Germany. His research interests include Laser medicine, Antimicrobial Photodynamic Therapy, Photodynamic Therapy, Photobiology, Fluorescence Imaging, and Spectroscopy.

He is consultant for preclinical and clinical evaluation of medical laser applications, for research on photobiology, photosensitizers, fluorescence imaging, and light sources with many companies. He is Co-founder of the company Trioptotec GmbH, Regensburg.

He teaches students at the Faculty of Medicine and the Faculty of Physics, University of Regensburg and supervised more than 50 master or PhD in Physics, Chemistry, Biology, and Medicine. He published more than 120 original articles in peer reviewed journals and 27 book articles.

He is member of the German Society of Laser medicine, European Society of Photobiology, European Society of Tattoo Pigment Research (Co-founder and Board Member), and the Scientific Advisory Board of the Federal Institute for Risk Assessment (BfR, Berlin Germany).
